



Towards organic farming is a win, win, win




Science shows that organic farming protects us from toxic pesticides and is more profitable for farmers while conserving the soil, water and biodiversity that we need to feed the world for generations to come





Even though the employee population is only 14%, the services and CSR activities offered by Bogawantalawa benefits the entire population of its estates.


